

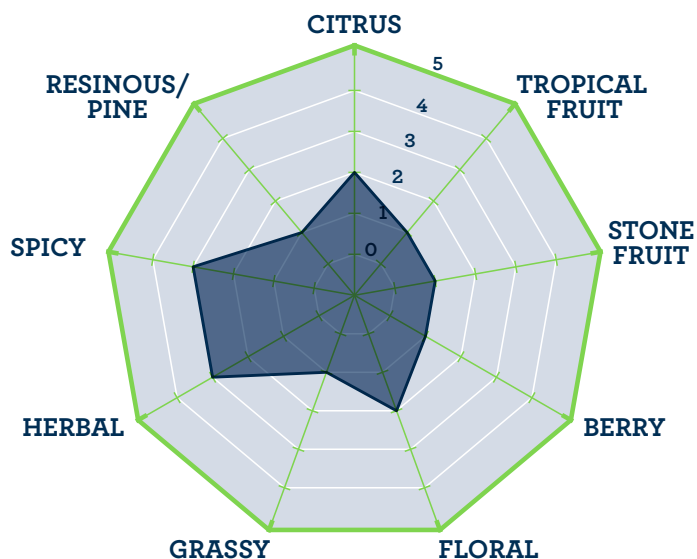
# AURUM

## Breeding / Development:

Germany. Aurum is a daughter of Tettninger crossed with a Hüll breeding line. It was developed with the goals of high aroma capacity plus improved tolerance to both pests and extreme weather conditions. Named after the Latin word for gold.



**Sensory:** Spicy, herbaceous notes with a fresh citrus aroma.

**Brewing Application:** Aroma. Offers a “classic” German noble hop character when used for late additions in lagers, Kölsch, Altbier, and similar beer styles. Aurum was developed and designed to have a higher oil content, and offers a high transfer of aromatic compounds in the brewing process.
